  - Many people are leaving for greener pastures and there currently isn't a replacement plan.
  - Fishing season BE AWARE! There are different regulations on different lakes. Know where
    you are and what the limits are.
  - Hunting seasons
    - Pink is allowed, but it is less visible (15-20% of male population is colorblind)
    - Back tag elimination has incurred both positive and negative responses
    - GO WILD print out license copies to keep with you.
    - No deer tag required to be attached this year as long as you are WITH your deer.

- Federal Migratory Bird Stamp still required to be signed and with you while hunting.
- Per Al the "system" is evolving, and per Mark Doug is vigilant on the lake. As an FYI, a 52" musky was caught (and released) on Okauchee.
