WCCA Meeting Minutes June 20, 2018

President Al Shook called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm at the Stone Bank Sportsmen's Club. The meeting was sponsored by the Stone Bank Sportsmen's Club, who provided the refreshments. The meeting was attended by 17 individuals, comprised of club delegates and the Wisconsin Conservation Congress.

Per the Treasure's request, the notes were read by Al Shook. Dues were collected and funds dispersed for the following expenses: Ojibwa grant; Take Aim at Cancer grant; Walk, Run and Roll grant; web hosting payment; WCCA attendee WWF annual meeting expenses; secretary expenses; banner and sign purchases; raffle license renewal; raffle payout; WCSFO dues.

April raffle net income was \$1,251. About 92% of the tickets were sold.
