August 5, 2024

Chairman Robert C. Hultquist called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m. Supervisors present included John Koepke, John Roelandts, Erik Mullett and VJ Scully. <u>Approve Minutes from Town Board meeting July 15, 2024</u>. – Supervisor Koepke made the motion to approve the July 15, 2024, meeting minutes as presented. Supervisor Scully seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Comments from the Floor on Agenda items or any other items.

Barbara that represents Badgerland Ski Team, introduced herself and the Team to the Board and what they represent.

Chairman Hultquist changed the order and started with Chief Bowen's report under new business.

- Consider and Act on Badgerland Ski Team to perform a ski show in the main channel on Okauchee Lake. – Per the recommendation of Police Chief Wraalstad, the Board took no action on this matter
